# Boer Goat 101: Understanding the Herd Prefix

We want to start the new year with new ways to communicate about ABGA. One way is better educating our new members. We asked our Accounts Receivable Manager Sonia Cervantez to write about the herd prefix.

When new members join, they don't always understand what they are signing up for besides a goat membership.

Because the herd prefix should be better explained at the time of joining and not after the fact, we want to fully explain it right now in hopes of preventing them from creating a problem later. The herd prefix is what will be tattooed in the goat's right ear if it is born at your farm.

It needs to be at least 3 characters and no more than 5 characters. It can be letters, numbers or a combination. They need to keep them, simple, short and not duplicate characters. They also cannot be one letter followed by a series of numbers, such as A1234.

When new members join, it gives the option to provide 3 choices on the form. But it really doesn't explain this until you go to read the Rules or Register a Goat. That's when members realize they messed up, and there is no changing it because of the Rules & Regulations.

If a family would like to share the same herd prefix, they have the option. Otherwise, no 2 members can have the same herd prefix.

If you are the breeder of a goat and you would like it registered through ABGA, then a herd prefix is required. Both ears need to be tattooed unless you microchip (stay tuned - next month we'll explain the left tattoo). This even applies to non-members. If you are a non-member, the herd prefix is a one-time \$10 filing fee.

cannot put your name in to judge any of the ABGA or JABGA National Shows.

They transitioned their herd to registered Boer goats in 2018 and have been breeding, showing and selling registered stock ever since. Located in Flovilla, Ga, they own Bent Wheel Boer Goats.

"Ashley wants to be a livestock vet, and the connections we have made and lessons we have learned have been beyond helpful for her future goals. She is very active with everything with the goats. - JABGA National Market and Commercial Doe Show and JABGA Market and Commercial Showmanship.

If you miss this deadline, you will not be a candidate for the 2022 ABGA/JABGA National Shows.

- Judges are required to be a 2022 member in good standing with the ABGA and dues paid by Jan. 1, 2022.
- To qualify as an ABGA/JABGA National Show candidate, interested judges must be an approved Level I ABGA Judge by Jan. 2, 2022.

- Judges for the JABGA National Show must select ONE other active approved judge to form a team of two. The team members must originate from different ABGA Regions. Each judge can only be listed on a maximum of two teams for the JABGA National Show. Each member of your team must sign and submit their judges' replies for your team to be eligible. Judges will be required to talk reasons through at least 10th place in all classes.
- Judges will be required to use a placing method set forth and approved by the ABGA Board of Directors.

# Baked Goat Lasagna

# ingredients

1 package lasagna noodles, cooked as per package directions

SAUCE:

1/2 C onion, chopped

½ tsp. garlic powder

26-ounce cans tomato paste

2 1/2 C water

1 1/2 tsp. salt

1/2 tsp. black pepper

1 lb. ricotta cheese

About % C grated Parmesan cheese

1 tsp. oregano

1 lb. ground goat meat

# directions

Put 2 tablespoons of olive oil in deep pan and cook onion until tender. Add ground goat until done. Add spices, tomato paste and water. Simmer about 25 minutes, stirring so it doesn't stick. Spread several spoonfuls of sauce into large, shallow well-greased pan. Then alternate layers of lasagna, sauce and cheese, ending with the cheese. Bake about 20 to 30 minutes in 350-degree oven. Cut into squares to serve.
